## Solution 2: Infrastructure for Homes and Jobs Boost the economy and unlock more homes by building our communities

**Problem:** Ontario is facing a housing crisis, needing 1.5 million more homes by 2031. We're at the centre—already home to 75% of Ontarians and some of the fastest-growing areas in Ontario.

**Homes need infrastructure.** Housing depends on the essential municipal infrastructure we build – water and sewers, roads and transit, waste management, and more. Without toilets that flush, roads that connect, and pipes in the ground, houses can't be built and businesses can't expand.

**Infrastructure supports the economy.** Every \$1 invested in infrastructure delivers up to \$6 return on investment.

**Municipalities can't do it alone.** Municipalities pay over 70% of the cost – and municipal resources aren't keeping up with the scale of need or pace of growth.

**Need:** We need more housing-enabling infrastructure, fast—to catch up with growth, unlock more homes, and stimulate Ontario's economy.

Solution: Establish long-term, predictable, and substantial infrastructure funding to support more homes – including building new and maintaining existing stock to support intensification.
